She currently serves as the board chairman for the People's Partners for Community Development, which provides financial literacy education to community members and small business development through small loans, Individual Development

Accounts and tax preparation assistance. A board member of the Cheyenne Children Services, which is a direct services program for low to moderate income families through donations of children's winter coats, diapers, infant formula and school supplies, a member of the Hopa Mountain Board which is based out of Bozeman, Montana, a member of the Leadership Montana Governance Board, a board member of the State of Montana Governor's Commission on Community Service and a Montana Ambassador.
